



INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME (X2 INTERNS)

The Komati Basin Water Authority (KOBWA) is a bi-national River Basin Authority established under a Treaty between the Republic of South Africa (RSA) and the Kingdom of Eswatini (KOE), to develop and manage water resources in the Komati sub-catchment. KOBWA operates from its Head Office at Maguga Dam near Pigg's Peak in Eswatini and has an Operations (Water Management) Office at Driekoppies Dam near Schoemansdal in South Africa.

KOBWA is seeking to recruit two (2) suitably qualified candidates for an **Internship Programme** to be based at Driekoppies Dam with extensive travel in the KOBWA's area of operation (RSA & KOE).

PROJECT MANAGEMENT INTERNS – 12 MONTHS

Requirements

- National Diploma in Project Management, Construction Management, or Civil Engineering from a recognized University or University of Technology.
- Computer literacy with strong written, verbal, and interpersonal communication skills.
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office (Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Project).
- Skills in data analysis, report writing, and presentation.
- Strong organizational skills, problem-solving ability, and critical thinking.

Duties and Responsibilities

Working under the Project Management Unit, the interns will assist with the following:

- Coordination and monitoring of large-scale projects related to dam infrastructure and facilities.
- Support the preparation of project documents, including progress reports, schedules, and meeting records.
- Track project activities against timelines and budgets and flag potential risks or delays.
- Participate in site inspections and contractor meetings under supervision.
- Assist with stakeholder engagement for project-related activities.
